PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT:
(specify probable cause. for each charge)
Before Me. the undersigned authority personally appeared SGT. ADAM HELFANT who being duly sworn, alleges, on information and belief, that on the 11 day of JANUARY 2018 in LAKE County, Florida, the defendant did:

DID COMMIT THE OFFENSE OF DISRUPTION OF SCHOOL FACILITY IN THE CITY OF MOUNT DORA.

On January 11th, 2018 I responded to the Mount Dora High School in reference to a student who was heard trying to obtain a firearms. Upon my arrival, I made contact with Ofc. Severance who was in building 4 with both the student (Charles Gould) and school administrators. Ofc. Severance advised two students directly heard Gould speaking on his cellular phone with an unknown person asking for a "9 or 45" to protect himself and his family. A third student approached Gould and directly asked him what he was doing. Gould responded by saying he was going to get "jumped" and he was going to get a gun to shoot them. Sworn written affidavits were obtained from all three student witnesses.

I then spoke with Gould in an administration room located in building 4. I started my conversation with Gould by completing a Mount Dora Police Department Constitutional Rights form. Gould said he had difficulty reading, but was able to read the majority of this document. Gould was explained his constitutional rights in depth. Gould was also asked to explain each right to me in his own way to ensure he understood. Gould decided to waive his rights and speak with me. Gould explained he was being bullied by five students and was fearful he was going to be jumped by them. Gould decided he was going to obtain a gun to protect himself and his family. Gould said he called his friend _____ in an attempt to obtain a gun. _____ told Gould he was unable to help obtain a gun.

The Mount Dora Police Department and school officials received multiple phone calls from parents who had already heard a student was trying to bring a gun to school for the purpose of shooting other students. This information was being spread to the point the Mount Dora Middle School Student Resource Officer, Ofc. Garcia was receiving phone calls from parents who were concerned about the well-being of their children.

Charles actions caused a significant disruption not only to the Mount Dora High School, but also to the Mount Dora Middle School. Gould was placed under arrest and transported to the Mount Dora Police Department for processing. Gould was later transported to the Lake County Jail for booking.

Narrative

On Thursday, January 11, 2018, at approximately 1344 hours, I was assigned to work at the Mount Dora High School located at 700 N. Highland Street in Mount Dora. During my time at the high school, multiple students came to the main office with concerns regarding rumors of a student wearing an M&M jacket who was possibly carrying a gun and/or was going to shoot at other students.

At approximately 1300 hours, six students came into the main office to provide statements of rumors of a student that was telling other that he was going to shoot at other students. The complainants unanimously stated they did not know who was the student making the threats but they all described him as a white male wearing a M&M jacket.

At approximately 1340 hours, several students came into the main office stating they were posting flyers in hallways by building 4, when they heard a student conversation on a cell phone, asked someone to deliver a "45" or "9" gun to him at the school to protect himself and his family. The complainants described the student as a white male, wearing an M&M jacket.

As I walked to building 4 in company of school staff, I requested additional units for the safety of the students and school personnel. I made contact with 20-year-old student, Charles D. Gould, whom I safely isolated him from the rest of the classroom. While in the hallway, I conducted a pat-down in search for concealed weapons, but met with negative results. School staff searched inside Gould's backpack for concealed weapons, but met with negative results.

I escorted Gould to an office adjacent in building 4. While waiting for Sgt. A. Helfant, Gould spontaneously and repeatedly uttered that he has been bullied by other students and he was scared he was going to be jumped by them.

Once Sgt. Helfant arrived to our location he helped Gould understand and read the Mount Dora Police Department Constitutional Rights form. Gould stated he had difficulty reading, but was able to read the document. Sgt. Helfant took his time and explained one by one the constitutional rights to Gould.

I then returned to the main office where I met with several of the complainants to collect sworn statements.

I spoke with _____, who provided the following in his sworn written affidavit. _____ stated he was at lunch, when other students came up to him saying a dude with an M&M jacket had a gun and he was going to shoot up the school. _____ stated he went to talk to him (Gould), whom told _____ "Your boys keep saying they are going to jump me". _____ stated the other student involved in the incident against Gould was _____.

I spoke with _____, who provided the following information and completed a sworn written affidavit. _____ stated during lunch time, people were saying that another student had a gun on him and that he was going to shoot up the school and all the African American people. _____ also heard the student was getting help from his dad's friend. _____ stated the other students involved in the incident wanting to jump Gould are _____ and _____.

I spoke with _____, who provided the following information and completed a sworn written affidavit. _____ stated a student wearing a gray and orange jacket came to his table during lunch saying that another student had a gun and he was going to shoot up the school and some black kids.

I spoke with _____, who provided the following statement and completed a sworn written affidavit. _____ stated he and _____ were posting flyers in the hallways and door of building 4 when they heard a student talking on a cell phone.

stated the student said that he needed a ".45 or .9 or whatever you can get" to bring to the school. describe the student to be a white male, wearing an M&M jacket.

I spoke with who provided the following information and completed a sworn written statement. stated he heard a student talking on a phone and making plans to get a gun. in the conversation, he heard the student said the gun was to protect his family. also heard him mention the numbers 45 and 9. describe the student as to have a white male, buzz cut, and an M&M jacket.

I learned later the name of the person Charles Gould called and asked for the guns was , whom Cpl. J. Howell spoke with via cell phone.

Gould actions caused a significant disruption not only to students and classes at the Mount Dora High School, but also to the Mount Dora Middle School. Concerned parents from students in both schools called school officials and the Mount Dora Police Department concerned about the well-being of their children.

Gould was placed under arrest and transported to the Mount Dora Police Department for processing. Gould was later transported to the Lake County Jail for booking.
