

90% Response Time Growth \*


\* Only 63% of incidents in 4:00 minutes or less (per Fitch Report)




### 3 Stations = 4 Minute Travel For 85% Of Calls



| Revenue             | \$2,195,552 | \$1,888,047 | \$1,411,386 | \$1,103,881 |
